StringBuilder sb = new StringBuilder(); StringBuffer sb2 = new StringBuffer(); String s2 = "1234567"; Matcher m = Pattern.compile("[a-zA-Z0-9]+").matcher(s); Matcher m2 = Pattern.compile("[a-zA-Z0-9]+").matcher(s2); while(m.find()) { sb.append(m.group()); sb2.append(m2.group()); } I'm not sure, but I think that in this case I have to add {1} to matcher, so I've tried this: m.find() { sb.append(m.group()); sb2.append(m2.group()); } But I got an error: "The method find() is undefined for the type Matcher".
